

NOTICE OF MAKING OF AN ORDER
HIGHWAYS ACT 1980
WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981

SOUTH GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNCIL
(FOOTPATHS OAN 23 AND OAN 24 AT FORTY ACRE FARM, ALVESTON) PUBLIC PATH
DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2021

The above order, made on 23 June 2021, under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will divert that length of **public footpath OAN 23**, Alveston which extends from Point A (grid reference ST 6388 8716) where it meets the unaffected part of the footpath, running in a south south westerly direction to and through the garden of Forty Acre Farm, curving around buildings and through the yard, for a distance of 115 metres to Point B (grid reference ST 6381 8708) where it meets the adopted highway on Forty Acre Lane/public footpath OAN 24, shown marked A - B on the order map and that length of **public footpath OAN 24**, Alveston which extends from the said Point B, running in a south easterly direction between farm buildings and the field boundary, for a distance of 158 metres then curving round a pond in the field corner to Point E (grid reference ST 6392 8697) where it meets the field boundary and the unaffected part of the footpath, shown by a bold black line marked B - E on order map -

to a new line: (**public footpath OAN 23**) from the said Point A running in a generally west north westerly direction along a track and then bearing off in a similar direction across the field for a distance of 206 metres to the corner of the field at Point D (grid reference ST 6369 8722) where it meets the adopted highway on Forty Acre Lane, having a width throughout of 2 metres and shown by a bold broken line marked A - D on the order map and (**public footpath OAN 24**) from the said Point A running in a south easterly direction alongside the field boundary for a distance of 190 metres to Point C (grid reference ST 6400 8702) in the corner of the field then turning to run along the field boundary in a generally south westerly direction to Point E (ST 6392 8697) in the corner of the field near the pond where it meets the unaffected part of the footpath at the boundary, having a width throughout of 2 metres from the face of the hedge and shown by a bold broken line marked A - C - E on the order map.

A copy of the order and the order map *and an explanatory statement* have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Yate One Stop Shop (next to the Leisure Centre), Kennedy Way, Yate during normal offices hours. Any representation about or objection to the order may be sent or delivered in writing addressed to the Head of Legal and Democratic Services at the undermentioned address quoting reference L3/DF/STOR/PT.6716 not later than 20 August 2021. Please state the grounds on which they are made. Please note that all representations received may be considered in public by the Council and that the substance of any representation together with the name and address of the person making it could become available for public inspection.

If no such representations or objections are duly made, or if any so made are withdrawn, South Gloucestershire District Council may confirm the order as an unopposed order. If the order is sent to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation any representations or objections which have not been withdrawn will be sent with the order.
