Mr T. Benwell relating to application - P19/3973/F

Mr Benwell presented to Clirs plans and photographs of the proposals for the above application, stating that there were discrepancies between what was reported on the SGC planning portal and the details of the actual submission. He wished to make the Parish Council aware of this. He stated that it his intention to extend to accommodate an office and not three additional bedrooms as stated and that the Parish Council submitted (in error) their support of the comments made by the planning officer, this was an incorrect statement as it was the comments of the Conservation Officer that the Parish Council supported (comments Mr Benwell perceived as incorrect). Objections were raised relating to the shape of the proposed building as "L" shaped which was noted as a "change". Mr Benwell remarked that both neighbouring buildings were already "L" shaped.

P190520-01: Submit an amendment to the Parish Council comment relating to P19/3973/F stating that "The Parish Council wish to rectify an error made in their previous statement issued. The Parish Council stated that "APC fully supports the recommendation for refusal by South Glos Planning Officer." The Council wish to retract that comment and restate as follows, "APC fully supports the recommendation for refusal by South Glos Conservation Officer"."

Action to (Clerk)

Mr G Buckley expressed concerns that South Glos Council are incorrectly posting information relating to his property with regard to application P19/5000/O. These errors should have been rectified by SGC but unfortunately continued to be resubmitted with revised applications.

Members of the public raised concerns relating to the use of the bridal way as a road to accommodate vehicles. (Clerk) informed Cllrs and the Public that he had contacted the SGC Footpaths & rights of way team as he had not seen their comments on the SGC planning portal.

Members of the Public raised concerns that this is not infill but encroaching on the "Green Belt"
